

## New Records of Tiger Beetle Species from the Malaysian Peninsular (II)<sup>1)</sup> (Coleoptera: Cicindelidae)

Abstract: *Callytron doriai* (Horn, 1897) and *Enantiola hewittii* (Horn, 1908) are recorded for the first time from the Malaysian Peninsular (= Malacca). The number of tiger beetle species known from Malacca raised up to 71.

The tiger beetles, which were collected during that stay are listed in the following. All material is conserved in the Loodusmuuseum, some duplicates are deposited in the authors's collection.

### Results

#### *Tricondyla (Tricondyla) annulicornis* Schmidt-Goebel, 1846

Distribution: Myanmar, Malaysian Peninsular, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam.
