

## Heteroceridae (Coleoptera) of Bhutan

**Abstract:** *Augyles schmidtjaegeri* Mascagni, 1998, *A. terzanii* Mascagni, 1995 and *A. laticollis* Mamitza, 1933 are reported from Bhutan for the first time. Occurrence of *A. marschalli* Mamitza, 1928 in Bhutan is probable.

### Introduction

During my study of Heteroceridae deposited in the Natural History Museum, Vienna (Austria) I found a few specimens collected in Bhutan (Provinces Sarpang and Punakha). I do not know any record of Heteroceridae from this country and the three species (*A. schmidtjaegeri* Mascagni, 1998, *A. terzanii* Mascagni, 1995 and *A. laticollis* Mamitza, 1933) represent the first Heteroceridae for Bhutan. In addition, one female specimen observed is probably *A. marschalli* Mamitza, 1928, however, its occurrence in Bhutan must be confirmed by the find of male specimens.

There are nine widely dispersed species of *Augyles* Schiödte, 1866 (*A. cantus* Miller, 1995; *A. feae* Grouvelle, 1896; *A. formicatus* Mamitza, 1933; *A. grohmanii* Mascagni, 1987; *A. ivojenisi* Mascagni, 1995; *A. laticollis* Mamitza, 1933; *A. manfredjaechi* Mascagni, 1995; *A. pucholti* Skalický, 2001) and four species of *Heterocerus* Fabricius, 1792 (*H. lorenzvae* Mascagni, 1993; *H. magnus* Mamitza, 1933; *H. nepalensis* Mascagni, 1933; *H. virgatus* Mamitza, 1933) known also from the adjacent countries India and Nepal (MASCAGNI 1995a, 1995b, 1998, MASCAGNI & SFORZI. 1999).
